Moderate any lesson plan to meet the needs of ALL riders where possible. If a rider is deemed to be unsafe in the group working environment they must be encouraged to play an observational role and be directed to an appropriate private lesson or more suitable group. Ensure coaches are aware of the changes to some horses behaviour in group scenarios, modify lesson plan accordingly. Be aware that some riders will behave and react differently in group situations, modify lesson plan accordingly.
