Young persons may not use any machinery, unless training has been given and recorded in writing on the risk assessment and in the staff file. Young person's must not carry out: clipping, lunging or loading horses unless fully supervised. They should not be expected to ride horses that are unsuitable for persons in the age group or who may be inexperienced. They must receive training in appropriate lifting procedures, general hygiene, COSHH and Fire Procedures. They must be aware of the risks around horses and the health and safety requirements. They must understand the importance of good hygiene. They should receive an induction as per all staff members. They should wear hard hats, gloves and non-slip boots at all times when working around horses, as well as suitable trousers and tops. No jewellery to be worn Mobiles phones not to be used in the workplace unless in an emergency or during break/lunch times.
